

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

These addendum rules have been developed for the safety and well being of all those in attendance as well as the staff and volunteers. Strict adherence to these rules will be enforced. Those not adhering to these rules, as stated below, will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately.

To be able to have as few people on the show grounds as possible at one time, NO SPECTATORS or non-essential people will be permitted during the show. Participants and one trainer/assistant ONLY. Please plan to arrive 1 hour or less before your ride time and depart immediately after. For trainers bringing multiple clients in one trailer, or those traveling together, we will be grouping you tightly together for this show. Accommodating big gaps between riders won't be possible at this time.

Participants are required to self-monitor their temperature prior to entering the show grounds. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5 or above is not permitted to enter the show grounds.

Anyone who has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 2 weeks or is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms may not enter the show grounds.

1. Face coverings are REQUIRED at all times unless you are on the back of a horse or ringside giving instructions or calling a test. Bring your own mask.
2. Comply with the minimum of 6 ft social distancing requirements at all times. Bring your own mask. Barns that come together should stay together.
3. NO ONE but the rider and trainer or assistant will be permitted on the show grounds. In the case of a minor, 1 parent will also be permitted to attend. No spectators will be permitted and no seating will be available on the show grounds.
4. Practice proper social distancing practices in the trailer parking area.
5. There will be no food or snacks offered at the shows so please plan accordingly. There will be water available.
6. Please wash hand regularly and adhere to other sanitation practices (a hand washing station will be available) Bring hand sanitizer and wash frequently.
7. The barns and other facilities at Black Dog Farm are off limits to incoming horses and people.
8. Rides may be scheduled out of class order so groups which come together can leave as soon as possible. Scoring of classes may not be finished until the end of the day. Tests that cannot be released will be mailed to the rider. Results will be posted at www.tev-cds.com.
9. Be sure your entries are submitted in perfect form, with all signatures and paid in full. No last-minute finishing of entries or changes to entries will be allowed.
